### **Creating a Podium for Helen DeVos Children's Hospital**

Vos Glass, Inc. was honored to be entrusted with the construction of the podium curtainwall of the new Helen DeVos Children's Hospital in Grand Rapids. The podium has a distinctly different and unique glazing design and system from the cylindrical main tower that rises from it. Highly visible at street level, the podium's blue, green and silver glass and curving metal waves offer an engaging sight to visitors, pedestrians and vehicular traffic.

The podium consists of a glass and aluminum curtainwall that stretches along Michigan Street and Bostwick Avenue. A custom Kawneer four-sided, structural silicone-glazed curtainwall system was chosen for the project.

One of the most challenging aspects of the project was the development and installation of a sloped glass system at the corner of the building. This challenging design called for a complicated layout and fabrication, and the installation of custom trapezoid-shaped aluminum systems and insulated glass.

Over 16,000 square feet of energy-efficient, reflective blue, green and metallic silver glass were installed. To support LEED certification and promote easy, environmentally-friendly cleaning, the exterior insulated units were constructed with outboard lite Pilkington Activ<sup>TM</sup>glass, a sophisticated coated glass product.

The unique design required over 900 panes of glass, each having a unique size and alignment. Each unit of glass had to be offset from the next to follow the distinctive pattern of the aluminum wave panels that flow along the length of the building.

An additional challenge: over a thousand custom-designed and-fabricated brackets were mounted before the glass installation for attachment of the multiple layers of aluminum wave panels. Brackets were precisely positioned by laser guidance technology to ensure accurate alignment.

Its successful completion is the result of our glazing craftsmanship along with the skilled coordination and planning on the part of the Wolverine Construction Management team and the expertise of GMB design professionals.



### Calvin College Sculpture Collaboration with Vos Glass, Inc.

In April 2010, Calvin College Architecture and Studio Art students were invited to develop designs for a glass sculpture to hang in the student lounge/east lobby of the college's renovated Covenant Fine Arts Center (CFAC). The students were asked to consider the concepts of covenant and community, and to think about the role of the space in illuminating the fine arts to visitors as well as those passing by.

The winning concept, created by students Hannah Abma, Jeremia Handoko, Brianna Perez and Yohan Na, was refined over the summer with the help of the college's architect, Frank Gorman, along with a team from Vos Glass, Inc. and their partners, Echo Etching and Accuform Industries, Inc.

The final piece is composed of five large circular panes of glass, in graduated sizes, held in metal bands that are suspended from the ceiling. The five panes represent the multiple elements of the fine arts, while the varying colors, textures and circular shapes reference the continuity idea of covenant and community. Dramatic and inspiring, the sculpture celebrates the renewal of the fine arts structure and provides a meaningful welcome at the entrance.

This project gave us the opportunity to work with students and support Calvin in a truly creative project," said Linda J. Vos-Graham, president of Vos Glass, Inc. "It's a beautiful design that combines art and architectural features, and a great example of what can be achieved in a non-traditional working relationship."
